CODE OF CONDUCT

To ensure that our statement of purpose is being met, it is vital all participants, staff and volunteers understand and comply with our Code of Conduct so that **Play It Forward** is always a safe, happy, supportive and encouraging environment for everyone involved.

To this end, we ask that each participant agrees to follow our "5 PIF PRINCIPLES":

1. SHOW RESPECT

Act and speak respectfully. This includes all participants, staff, volunteers and guests by respecting the beliefs, needs and backgrounds of others and by caring for the property and possessions of everyone. Remember that you are an ambassador of **Play It Forward**. Be proud of what you have achieved and learnt and work together to support others to create a great team effort.

2. BE ACCOUNTABLE

Take personal responsibility for your involvement in our programs. This includes attending and being punctual at rehearsals and events, wearing the appropriate attire, listening and following the instructions of your musical leaders and management team, making sure you come prepared (eg. correct music, pencil, water bottle, food, medications as needed, costumes, etc), supporting members of your team, and keeping management informed if you have any issues (we are here to help to you as much as we can).

3. BE EMPATHETIC

Create an inclusive and welcoming environment by maintaining a positive outlook & relationships, being sensitive and supportive to those around you and working cooperatively for the benefit of all participants.

4. BE KIND

Choose your words and actions carefully. As our parents used to say: "If you don't have anything kind to say, don't say anything at all". Sometimes a smile and saying hello can make the world of difference if someone is having a bad day:)

5. HAVE FUN

Enjoy yourself and have fun! Please always remember that you are here because you have chosen to be, and as much as we want to give of our best all the time, it is important to enjoy the journey and make sure you are having fun along the way!
